Interest in instrumentation or theory will be an asset, and other areas of astronomical research will be considered in exceptional cases. Responsibilities include teaching at both undergraduate and graduate level, research, participation in public outreach, and administration.

Candidates should show evidence of outstanding accomplishments in research, have a demonstrated capacity in teaching and interest in supervision of theses, the potential to motivate students and develop significant research programs with them, and the willingness to work as a team member in a small group. The candidate will teach graduate courses (English or Spanish) and undergraduate ones (Spanish).
